Clean the inside of the pot with water and some special soap. That kills the bad bacteria. Rinse the pot with clear water before you put the soil into it. 3. Fill the pot to about an inch from the top with fresh, high-quality potting soil for vegetables and flowers. 4. Plant the basil seeds. Basil seeds are very small and it is difficult to pick them up. So take a small handful of seeds --- about five or six seeds --- and put them in the palm of one hand and then rub your hands together. That will distribute them evenly over the soil. 5. Cover the seeds with 1/4 inch of soil. Gently water them. 6. Place the pot outdoors in an area that gets full sun. Harvest the last of your basil before the frost comes! Frost will destroy your plant! 7. Indoors, place the pot near a sunny south window. Water the soil regularly. Then, after some days, the sprouts will come up. When the plants get bigger, don't let the soil dry out in the pot. When it is very hot and dry weather, the basil plant needs more water. But, be careful, do not overwater it!


